To be shown over 4 jumps at 4 feet. Performance only to count. In case of tie jumps will be raised.

Class 5 — OPEN HUNTER (Woodbourne Trophy)

To be shown over 4 jumps at 4 feet. Performance, manners and way of going 75%. Conformation 25%.

Class 6 — VERSATILITY OPEN JUMPING

To be shown over an in-and-out jump at 3 feet 6 inches, 24 feet apart, in-and-out to be jumped twice; a triple bar at 4 feet with 6 foot spread; and a standard high jump at 4 feet 6 inches. In case of tie the in-and-out and the high jump will be raised 6 inches, the triple bar will be spread 1 foot.

To be shown over 4 jumps at 4 feet. In case of tie jumps will be raised.

Ring to contain 4 jumps at 3 feet 6 inches. Course to be announced on day of show. Time plus faults to determine winner.

To be awarded to entry scoring the greatest number of points in classes 3, 5, 7, and 9.

Class 13 — JUMPER CHAMPIONSHIP

To be awarded to entry scoring the greatest number of points in classes 2, 4, 6, 8, and 10.
